

Environmental Policy Document

Harrabin Construction Limited is a professional and environmentally conscious organisation, which acknowledges the impact that our operation may potentially have on the environment. The clear objective of Harrabin Construction Limited is to minimise any impact on the environment by:

- Preventing pollution, reducing waste and ensuring that wherever practical, measures are implemented to protect and preserve the environment;
- Considering the effects that our operations may have on the local community;
- Taking action to eliminate or reduce, as far as practicable, any potentially adverse environmental impacts;
- Promoting environmental awareness amongst our suppliers, contractors and partners by implementation of operational procedures and choice of materials;
- Seeking to work in partnership with the community by behaving in a considerate and socially responsible manner. This includes registering larger schemes with Considerate Constructors and monitoring performance and reviewing and implementing action plans
- Employees are encouraged to examine their own activities and report any probable environmental affects to their supervisor
- Processes are chosen and performed in the most environmentally friendly manner, which is economically practical.

- Waste is disposed of in accordance with current legislation and a waste management plan is developed on a site specific basis that details waste segregation and recycling wherever possible
- Use recycled material wherever possible in the process of construction
- Source supplies from sustainable sources and only using timber sourced from environmentally sustainable suppliers

Management and site supervisory staff have responsibilities for the implementation of the policy and must ensure that environmental issues are given adequate consideration in the planning and day-today supervision of all work

Harrabin Construction Limited will comply with the duties placed upon it within the requirements of Statutory Legislation, whilst at all times complying with, as a matter of best practice, the requirements and duties set out within Approved Guidance as issued by the Environment Agency and other organisations.

All employees and sub-contractors are expected to co-operate and assist in the implementation of this policy, whilst ensuring that their own works, so far as is reasonably practicable, are carried out without risk to themselves, others or the environment. This includes co-operating with management on any environment related matter.

The Directors have overall responsibility for all environmental matters. The operation of this policy and the associated procedures will be monitored and reviewed on a regular basis to ensure that they remain current and applicable to Harrabin Construction Limited activities. The policy has been endorsed by the board of directors who give their full support to the implementation of the policy.
